### Health COVID update

- Approx 420 community members immunized: first dose
- Second dose clinics planned for early May
- Covid testing available for medical clinic patients
- Covid positive tracking (medical records)
- Rapid testing machine in the works
- Trailer for isolation to be purchased
- Food distribution for elders, families in need





- Seabird covid statistics
  - 62 community members tested
  - 7 positive for covid 19
  - 2 indeterminate and treated as covid positive



#### COVID care

- Health team liaise with Fraser Health and First Nations
   Health Authority to ensure all supports are in place for
   families with covid.
- Care kits for families on isolation
  - Over the counter medications
  - Cleaning supplies
  - Information
- "Full pantry" initiative for those isolating and struggling with food security





#### Finances

- ISC Surplus from previous fiscal year funding (2019/2020) \$43,950
- ISC initial Funding ICSF 2020/21 \$311,784
- ISC fall roll out of ICSF funding \$155,534
- ISC checkpoint funding \$161,280
- Total available funding for this fiscal year \$672,548
- Total spent to March 31/2021: \$586,046

#### Cost areas

- Check point initiative (spent to date \$267,762.92 = 11,156.79/week)
- Food security
- Renovations for covid safety
- Covid supplies and equipment
- Technology for Elders



- Check point initiative
  - ISC Checkpoint ICSF Funding approved to date: \$161,280
  - 26 staff hired
    - 75% Band/community members
    - 2 staff on at each check point
    - 24/7 coverage
      - Closed for two weeks for extreme weather
    - Shade stations at each check point
  - Color signs for community/staff for easy identification
