

Seabird – Enbridge Negotiations

We have been negotiating with Enbridge for roughly 30 years about the natural gas pipeline that runs through SIB reserve lands.

In the fall of 2020, a draft agreement was reached, which includes an annual amount for capacity training, and for future engagement purposes.

Seabird will receive a lump sum payment as full and final settlement for the existing pipelines and the rights granted under the right of way.

The final agreement is scheduled for final signature at the end of this month.

Seabird Island and Maria Slough Flood Response and Emergency Planning

 - a. Controls and/or infrastructure to control the water flow and flooding during freshet**

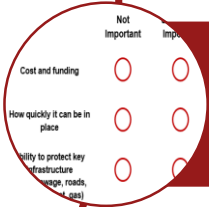
