GENERAL UPDATE

Child Protection Jurisdiction:

- 1. Continue to have community engagement session with both matriarchs and patriarchs. Compile data from meetings and develop plans from the input we received.
- 2. Job descriptions completed. Ready to interview for the three positions: Child protection manager, supervisor, and coordinator.

Community Well-being Initiative:

1. Our family development team and youth program do work to support our families that need it. Both teams do outreach to the parents and youth. We are planning for support groups for men and women to start soon. We are also planning for trauma resiliency training for staff and community members.

QAC Strat Planning:

- 1. We need to involve and update all of leadership on the importance of taking over our own jurisdiction of our children and families.
- 2. Housing is a concern for some of our families, we need to continue collaborating with housing and income assistance to address evictions, and house and yard cleanliness. We need a plan for those members that have lower capacity and need us to address the concerns on an ongoing basis.
- 3. Review our own community family model that will include:
 - Grandparents' roles
 - Elder role
 - Provide trauma informed training for staff and community members
