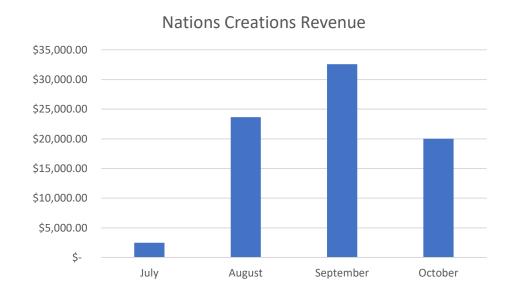


SIB Ec-Dev - Main Priorities: Q2

- Maintaining support for Employment Assistance Services over 150 employment positions were sent
- Headleases were completed for the several SIB properties (Whaleach, Eco-Station & Business Park) approval from Council is pending.
- Clean-up and management of Whaleach and Eco-station sites working is ongoing.
- Leasing of Whaleach and Eco-Stations properties Arkon Trucking, Pathfinder and Klassen Group are potential groups looking to invest at SIB.
- Retro-fitting of old barn buildings at Eco-Station site work in progress

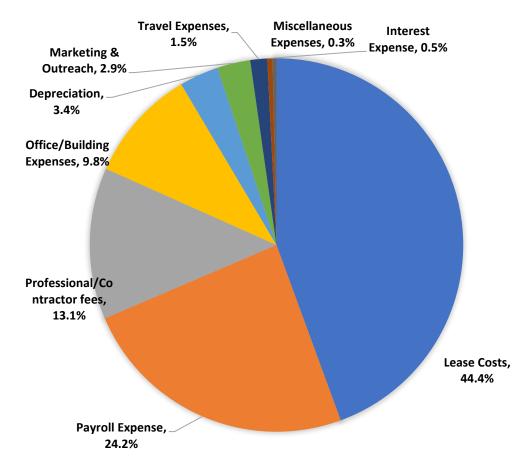

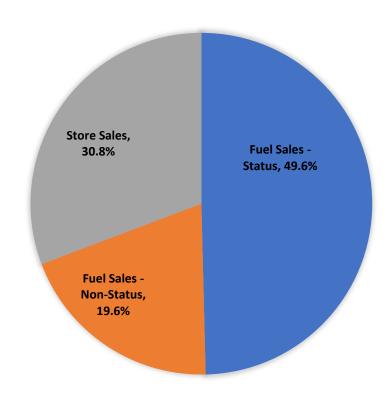

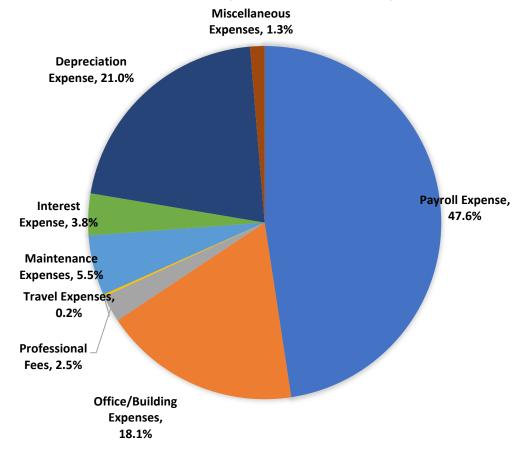

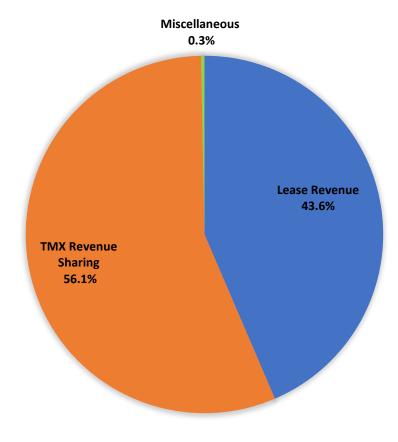
